

PROMAG ACOUSTIC PICKUP

INSTALLATION AND USE

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION

Dean Markley's ProMag™ Plus, Grand, and Gold magnetic soundhole pickups are by far the finest acoustic pickups available. Their patented design has the widest possible range of tones... warm full bass, smooth midrange, crystal clear highs, and the most brilliant harmonics you've ever heard. Made of real Curly Maple, ProMag™ is a natural complement to any acoustic guitar. ProMag™'s unique installation method makes them the quickest and easiest acoustic pickups to install and use.

1. Hold guitar in normal playing position. Slide the pickup under the strings from the treble side, making sure the pickup is positioned so the cord comes out the treble side. FIGURE 1. (There is no need to loosen the strings.)
2. Position the pickup in the center of the soundhole and line up the foam cushion against the bass side of the soundhole (FIGURE 2-A). Push up, compressing the foam, until the treble end clears the treble side of the soundhole. Then lower the pickup (2-B) until level, and let it slip into place (2-C). Adjust so pickup is lowered all the way in (against the guitar top). See below for further adjustments.

THAT'S IT !! Just plug into your amplifier system and play !!

NOTE: If the soundhole of your guitar is too small to let the pickup in, simply turn the pickup over and use a small file or sandpaper to round the needed amount off the treble end (file **only** the rounded wood under the felt). FIGURE 4. After checking for fit, proceed with installation starting with Figure 2.

Once your pickup is installed, you can easily adjust its position for more or less volume, as well as various combinations of bass and treble. If you want more volume, raise the entire pickup closer to the strings. FIGURE 3. For less volume, lower the pickup.

To accent the bass, raise the bass end towards the strings and lower the treble end FIGURE 5. For more treble, do the opposite.

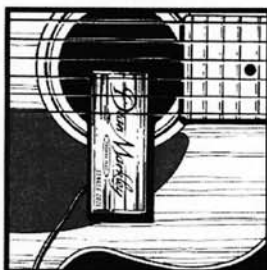

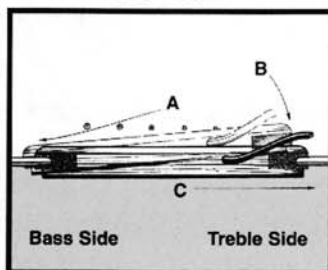

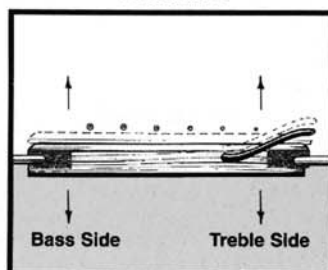

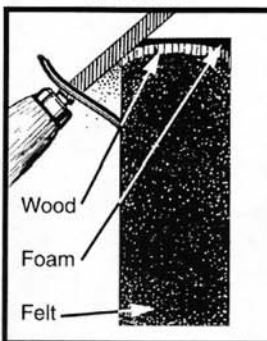

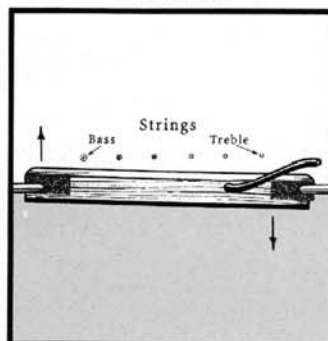
